Pyramid Writing Exercise

Every word counts in this exercise. The challenge for this writing assignment is to focus on word selection. Start with a single word--a one word sentence. As you build your story or essay try adding a word to each sentence. So, sentence two contains two words. Sentence three, three words, etc. Think of it as a pyramid where each individual brick is a word and each level (sentence) contains an increasing number of bricks/words.



The writing for this exercise demands that you pay attention to economizing your words and being intentionally concise.

Here's an example to get you thinking:

Daylight. Nothing more. It arrived unwanted. It arrived without pity.

Again, think of using a section of the Hero's Journey as your starter idea.
